MRD Update: consultants have provided 60% Plans. (see also Escambia County Engineering Project Page: <https://myescambia.com/open-government/projects/project-details/nas-pensacola-bay-living-shoreline-project>)
 - b. Comprehensive Water Way Management
MRD Update: MRD is continuing to gather information and working with Escambia County Attorney's Office to develop Draft Ordinance for MAC review and public input. The Draft Ordinance will then be presented to the Escambia County Board of County Commissioners (BCC). This is a long-term project and public/MAC input is welcome.
 - c. Optional Vessel Registration Fee (OVRF) – FL Statute 328.66
MRD Update: MRD will bring to BCC with direction from Natural Resources Management Director's approval upon MRD recommendation that sufficient public input has been received via MAC meetings. To date, very little public comment has been received, with little opportunity to inform and educate stakeholders of the necessity of the increase. MRD prefers to address any concerns and hold public discussion at MAC prior to requesting a Public Hearing. MRD has requested Escambia County Attorney analysis of "boating-related projects" projects (per Florida Statutes) to be considered for funding with OVRF

funds: construction and maintenance at new/existing boat ramps; maintenance dredging at boat ramps; boating safety; waterways signage; enforcement; design/engineering/permitting for new/existing boat ramps; internet cameras at boat ramps; artificial reefs, etc). Upon approval, Escambia County Community and Media Relations Department will issue a Press Release to solicit public input at future MAC meetings.

- a. The MAC agreed to formalize seeking another large vessel to reef in Escambia County.
- b. Holly Forester, Wendy Hoeflich and Emily Hoeflich presented marine turtle nesting data from Escambia County to the MAC in the November 8, 2021 meeting. They have asked the MAC to consider forwarding a letter to the Escambia County BCC to send to the FWC permitting office to allow for the marine turtle patrol to relocate low turtle nests that have been flooding/eroding severely for the last 5 years. These citizens plan to present a letter at the January 10, 2022 meeting to the MAC.
