 - **Term of Office, Vacancies and Removal.** All members shall serve a term of ***two (2) years***. A vacancy shall be filled by the appointing entity, and the replacement shall serve for the remainder of the unexpired term. ***Members whose terms have expired may be reappointed for additional two (2) year terms at the discretion of the appointing entity.***
 - **Officers: Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson.** The Advisory Board shall elect a Chairperson to preside at all meetings. The Chairperson shall be elected in October of each calendar year and shall serve a one-year term until the first meeting in October of the following year. There shall be no term limits for a member to serve as Chairperson. The Advisory Board shall also elect a Vice-Chairperson to preside and act on behalf of the Chairperson during his or her absence. The Vice-Chairperson shall be elected in October of each calendar year and shall serve a one-year term until the first meeting in October of the following year. There shall be no term limits for a member to serve as Vice-Chairperson.
